Abstracts should be submitted by the advertised deadlines for consideration for oral/poster presentation.

Abstracts should be submitted online

The abstract should have the following structure:

-Title of Abstract (with the text center justified) to include the title, author(s') names and affiliations (list multiple affiliations one below the other) and mark each with a superscript "a", "b", "c",). — In addition the name of the corresponding author, where there is more than one author, should be marked with an asterisk superscript (*).

*Corresponding author: E-mail:, Tel.:, Fax:"

-The Abstract should not be more than 250 words, with 6 to 8 keywords. your abstract to be included in the Book of Abstracts. We also request you to avoid lengthy introduction presentation and prepare your presentation either in 9 or 10 slides for effective presentation within 5-min.

General Format:

It should be one column. Leave on all sides a 2.5 cm margin and use 12 pts font, Tahoma throughout. Single spacing should be used. The text should not be hyphenated. Metric (SI) units should be used. Use unit symbols instead of words, e.g. "10 m" instead of "meter(s)" with a free space between the numerical value and unit symbol. Do not abbreviate units (e.g. no "pi" or "pels" instead of "pixel(s)". Also present units as 1 % and 4 %, not 1 to 4 %, or 2 mm to 5 mm, not 2 to 5 mm, or 3 km x 3 km, not 3 x 3 km. Also use correct mathematical symbols. Do not use bullets. Instead use numbering as (1) (2). There should be no footnotes.
