Better progression

During their undergraduate studies at VFSTR, students acquire two qualifications from Cambridge, i.e., PET and BEC. Each exam focuses on a level of the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), helping students to improve their speaking, writing, reading and listening skills step by step.

For this, students go through a structured language-learning curriculum, with clear objectives at each level of learning. They receive roughly 100 hours of rigorous training on the campus in the first and second year of engineering. In the course of training and preparing for the exams, students develop practical skills for the real world.

Real-life communication

The exams are based on real-life situations, helping students to develop the skills they need to communicate effectively. The speaking test is taken face to face with expert examiners deputed by Cambridge, so students are able to develop the ability to express their opinions and speak confidently in different contexts and situations.

Cambridge PET (Preliminary English Test) at B1 level of CEFR

Students who have trained and been certified with PET, (a B1 Preliminary qualification) shows that they have mastered the basics of spoken and written English, and can understand factual information and express opinions and mood. indicates that a student has mastered the basics of English and now have practical language skills for everyday use.

Cambridge BEC (Business English Certificate) at B2 level of CEFR

Possession of a B2 Business Vantage (BEC V) certificate indicates that a candidate has learned English to an appropriate standard and has gained the ability to use it in a professional context.

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) is an international standard for describing language ability. It describes language ability on a six-point scale, from A1 for beginners, up to C2 for those who have mastered a language with high proficiency. This makes it easy for anyone involved in language teaching and testing, such as teachers or learners, to see the level of different qualifications. It also means that employers and educational institutions can easily compare the qualifications to other exams in their country.
