Women's Empowerment Strengthens Society: Dr. Rayapati Sailaja



“Women’s empowerment does not weaken society; rather, it makes society stronger,” stated Dr. Rayapati Sailaja, Chairperson of the Andhra Pradesh Women’s Commission. She emphasized that when women are given leadership opportunities, positive transformation takes place within society.

A symposium titled “Rights, Justice, and Action for All Women and Girls” was organized on Friday to mark International Women’s Day celebrations. The program was inaugurated by the chief guest, Dr. Rayapati Sailaja, who lit the ceremonial lamp and addressed the gathering.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Sailaja emphasized that women’s empowerment strengthens society and leads to positive social transformation when

women are given leadership opportunities. She highlighted that the government had successfully achieved the target of creating one lakh women entrepreneurs in a year and is continuing to support women through various incentive schemes. She also stressed the importance of awareness about legal rights, cybersecurity, and laws such as Zero FIR and the POSH Act to ensure justice and protection for women.

Dr. Sailaja noted that initiatives like one-stop help centers and digital grievance systems are helping women access support and resolve complaints more quickly. She encouraged young women to focus on education, entrepreneurship, and self-employment to achieve economic independence and contribute to national development.

The symposium featured discussions on women’s rights, legal awareness, and social responsibility. Deans of various departments, legal experts, faculty members, and students participated in the event.

The program was organized under the guidance of the Head of the Department and coordinated by the faculty coordinators of the Vignan Institute of Law.
