



World Autism Awareness Day



The Psychology Program under the Department of Social Sciences and Humanities at VFSTR, Vadlamudi, organized an event in observance of World Autism Awareness Day on 2nd April 2026. The program began with a series of awareness activities conducted at the N Block Open Air Theatre (OAT).

The session was attended by B.Sc. and M.Sc. Psychology students along with faculty members. The lecture was conducted in online mode. The topic of the session was “Autism Through the Faculty Lens: Why Interventions Fail Without Family-Centered Practice.”

The resource person for the lecture was P. Hima Bindu, a rehabilitation psychologist from Hyderabad and founder of Ameya Child and Mind. The session provided valuable insights into autism intervention approaches and emphasized the importance of family-centered practices in supporting individuals with autism.

As part of the awareness program, students actively participated in various engaging activities to

demonstrate their understanding of autism. Role plays were performed to illustrate the characteristics and behavioral patterns commonly associated with autism. These performances helped the audience gain a clearer understanding of the challenges faced by individuals on the autism spectrum.

In addition, students explained common myths and facts about autism, aiming to spread accurate information and remove misconceptions surrounding the condition. Informative charts were also prepared and displayed by students to represent the autism spectrum and highlight important characteristics and features of autism.

These activities contributed to creating awareness, promoting empathy, and encouraging a more inclusive perspective toward individuals with autism. The program successfully enhanced knowledge among students and faculty members





and encouraged meaningful discussions on the importance of understanding and supporting individuals with autism.

The program was coordinated by Dr. B. Sivashankar Mandal, Dr. D. Rajyalakshmi, & Dr. Salomi M., assistant professors of psychology, under the guidance of Adam Stephen D., associate professor of sociology and head of the Department of Social Sciences and Humanities.
