The Department of Information Technology organized an innovative quiz event titled “AI-MEDHA TARANG-2K26” on 7th April 2026 to promote awareness and interest among students in the field of artificial intelligence. Students enthusiastically participated in the event. The quiz aimed to provide an engaging platform where students could test their knowledge, learn new concepts, and explore the rapidly growing domain of artificial intelligence.

The inaugural session was addressed by Dr. K. Sujatha, who highlighted the growing importance of artificial intelligence in modern technology and its impact on future careers. She also explained the objectives and structure of the quiz competition. The quiz was conducted by Dr. K. Praveen Kumar and Dr. Ziaul Haque Choudhury, who served as the quiz masters and guided the event effectively.

Around 60 students from II, III, and IV year IT participated in the competition and were organized into 11 teams to encourage teamwork and collaborative learning. The quiz covered topics such as artificial intelligence, machine learning, deep learning, and emerging technologies.

The competition included two preliminary rounds to test the basic knowledge of the teams. Based on their performance, the top four teams were shortlisted for the final stage, which consisted of two advanced rounds focusing on analytical thinking and application-based questions.

The event created a strong learning environment and encouraged students to enhance their knowledge in AI-related technologies. It also improved their logical thinking, problem-solving skills, and confidence





in participating in academic competitions. Such initiatives can further inspire students to explore future innovations in artificial intelligence, data science, and intelligent systems, encouraging them to stay updated with emerging technologies.

To further motivate the students, the winners were awarded cash prizes, making the event both competitive and rewarding for all participants.
