

# Rythu Sadassu 2026 - Bridging Farmers and Innovation



A Rythu Sadassu (Farmers’ Meet) and Agricultural Exhibition was successfully organized on 10 March 2026 at Vallabhapuram village, Kollipara Mandal, Guntur District, under the joint auspices of the Vignan Institute of Agriculture and Technology (VIAT), Vadlamudi, and the Department of Agriculture, Guntur, as part of the Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) Programme. The program was conducted by fourth-year B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture students placed in Kollipara, Vallabhapuram, Kolakaluru, Peddavadlapudi, Vejendla, Pedavegi, Munnangi, and Nutakki villages.

The event witnessed the participation of around 230 participants, including progressive farmers, local farmers of Vallabhapuram village, representatives from the Department of Agriculture, university representatives, students, and host farmers.

The program was graced by Prof. K. V. Krishna Kishore, In-charge Vice-Chancellor of Vignan’s University, as the Chief Guest, who emphasized the importance of climate-based agricultural advisories and modern technologies for improving farm productivity and income. Smt. M. Padmavathi, District Agricultural Officer, attended as guest of honor and explained various government schemes for farmers. Dr. D. Vijay Krishna, Dean, Training

& Placements, participated as Distinguished Guest, while Sri R. Vijay Babu, Assistant Director of Agriculture, and Sri N. Srinivasa Reddy, Mandal Agricultural Officer, attended as Honored Guests.

The event provided students with valuable first-hand exposure to rural agricultural conditions. They interacted with farmers, understood their challenges, and suggested scientific solutions and improved farming practices. The program featured student presentations, demonstrations of technological models, and exhibitions of agricultural products. Students also created awareness about major crop pests and diseases, including fall armyworm in maize, aphids in sorghum, Panama wilt in banana, rhizome rot in turmeric, and stem borer in maize. In addition, innovative models such as IoT-based agriculture, smart farming, micro-irrigation systems,



agritourism, microgreen production, and value-added products from tomato and moringa were demonstrated.

Students also displayed various agricultural products, including different turmeric varieties, arecanut, and black pepper, creating awareness among farmers about market opportunities and value addition.

The program was presided over by Dr. T. Ramesh Babu, Dean, VIAT, and coordinated by Dr. Harisha N, RAWE Coordinator, with the support of Dr. M. Chandra Surya Rao, HoD, VIAT, and director representatives Dr. Naresh, Dr. Bindu, Dr. Anusha, Dr. Srinivas, Mrs. Shama, Dr. Nagaraju, Mrs. Kavya, Dr. Yamuna, and Dr. Geetanjali.

The program concluded with the felicitation of farmers, strengthening collaboration between students and the farming community and promoting the effective transfer of agricultural knowledge.
