One-Day Workshop on Integrated Teacher Education Curriculum (ITEP)



The Department of Education, Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology and Research, Vadlamudi, successfully organized a One-Day Workshop on Integrated Teacher Education Curriculum (ITEP) on 9th April 2026 at the AFSD Facility, NTR Vignan Library.

The workshop focused on the implementation and academic framework of the four-year dual-degree programmes (B.A. B.Ed. & B.Sc. B.Ed.), aligning with the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which emphasizes multidisciplinary and integrated teacher education.

Dean IQAC Prof. M. Rama Krishna and Dean International students Prof. Sharada Allamneni welcomed both Resource persons Prof. Vanaja M and Dr. Rafi Mohmad and appreciated them for accepting our invitation. The event was enriched by the presence of eminent academicians Prof. Vanaja M, Dean, School of Education and Training, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, who has over three decades of experience in teacher education and

academic leadership. Member, Southern Regional Committee, NCTE & Dr. Rafi Mohmad, Associate Professor, Department of Education and Training, MANUU, an expert in educational psychology, counselling, and curriculum development.

The workshop commenced with a formal inaugural session, welcoming participants from various disciplines. The sessions were highly interactive and insightful. Prof. Vanaja M elaborated on the philosophical foundations of ITEP, Curriculum design principles aligned with NEP 2020 and The importance of integrating content knowledge, pedagogy, and field engagement. Dr. Rafi Mohmad focused on Learner-centric pedagogical approaches, Role of educational psychology and metacognition in teacher training. Integration of ICT and innovative teaching-learning



strategies. He also highlighted the significance of emotional well-being, assessment practices, and competency-based education in shaping future educators.

The workshop witnessed active participation from faculty members, research scholars, and students of the university. The interactive sessions, discussions, and Q&A segments facilitated a deeper understanding of the ITEP framework and its practical implementation.

Participants gained clarity on curriculum structure and credit distribution. Insights into interdisciplinary teaching approaches and Awareness of innovative pedagogical practices and assessment methods. The workshop concluded with a felicitation ceremony honouring the two resource persons, led by Prof. Sharada Allamneni Dean International Students, Dr. Vijaya Kumar Chavan, In-Charge Head of the Department of Education, along with the ITEP faculty members.
