## Workshop on Modern Web Technologies



A three-day workshop on “Building Modern Web Applications Using Django Integrated with MongoDB” organized by the Department of Computer Applications at Vignan’s Foundation for Science, Technology, and Research, Vadlamudi, to provide participants with practical knowledge in modern web development.

The workshop was conducted by industry experts Mr. Hari Prasanth, founder and full stack developer at SAS Infotech, Coimbatore, and Ms. Daranika Ravikumar, AI and prompt engineer.

The workshop introduced participants to the Django framework, its Model–View–Template architecture,

and the process of developing web applications. Through hands-on sessions, participants designed basic web pages, executed applications, and learned essential backend development concepts.

The sessions also focused on MongoDB, where attendees explored NoSQL databases, document-based storage, and database operations. Demonstrations on creating collections, inserting documents, and performing CRUD operations helped participants gain practical database experience.

## Salesforce Cloud - Shaping Future Developers

A value-added course on cloud computing with Salesforce and Salesforce-based cloud application development was conducted by the Department of Information Technology to enhance students’ knowledge of cloud technologies and enterprise application development. The program aimed to bridge the gap between academic learning and industry expectations by providing practical exposure to the widely used CRM platform Salesforce.



The course was organized for III B.Tech. Information Technology students, who actively participated in interactive sessions, demonstrations, and practical exercises. The sessions were conducted by industry expert G. Sravan Kumar, along with the internal coordinator D. Anandha Kumar, who provided valuable insights into Salesforce development and cloud-based enterprise solutions through real-time examples. During the sessions, students learned about cloud computing concepts, Salesforce architecture, standard and custom objects, reports, dashboards, and automation tools such as Salesforce Flow. Hands-on demonstrations helped students understand how enterprise applications are designed and deployed on cloud platforms. The program was inaugurated in the presence of K. Sujatha and M. Srikanth Yadav, who highlighted the growing importance of cloud computing skills for future IT professionals.
