Innovation Possible Through Academia - Industry Collaboration



K. P. M. S. V. Padmashree from the University of Hyderabad explained the role of the enzyme alternative oxidase in plant metabolism and its importance in crop improvement under climatic stress. Scientists, researchers, faculty, and students from various institutions participated and presented research papers.

The event was attended by Dr. R. V. Sridhar, Principal Scientist, Plant Cell Biotechnology at CSIR-CFTRI, Mysuru; Dr. Meka Jagannmohan Rao from Kuchipudi in Bapatla district; Vignan's Educational Institutions Chairman Dr. Lavu Rathaiah; Vice Chairman Lavu Sri Krishna Devarayalu; CEO Dr. Meghana Koorapati; In-charge Vice-Chancellor Prof. K. V. Krishna Kishore; along with deans, heads of departments, faculty members, research scholars, and students.

The Department of Biotechnology and Bioinformatics, School of Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical Sciences, organized a two-day national conference on "Plant Science Colloquium" at Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology, and Research, Vadlamudi, in the Guntur district.

At the beginning of the program, the ceremonial lamp was lit and the conference souvenir was unveiled. The book titled "Biotechnological Production of Bioactive Phytochemicals of Medicinal Value" was also released. Later, the Consortium Centre for Advanced Genomics Research Centre, established jointly by Genomics CARL Pvt. Ltd. and Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology, and Research, was inaugurated by Lavu Rathaiah, Chairman of Vignan's Educational Institutions.

Speaking on the occasion, Chief Guest Dr. Ratnagiri Polavarapu, president and CEO of Genomix Molecular Diagnostics Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, said that innovation is possible only when academia and industry work together. He emphasized that successful entrepreneurship requires a clear goal, systematic planning, dedication, and quality in products and services and encouraged students to develop a research mindset.

Prof. K. R. S. Sambasiva Rao, Vice Chancellor of Mangalyatan University, Jabalpur, highlighted the growing role of artificial intelligence in agriculture for improving crop yields, detecting diseases, and managing soil nutrients and water resources.



Industrial Lecture on Structural Engineering Software



The Department of Civil Engineering, VFSTR, organized an Industrial Expert Lecture on “Applications of Structural Engineering Software in Modern Industrial Practice.” The lecture was delivered by Mr. B. J. N. Satish, Senior Design Engineer, Archimedes Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, and former Board of Academic Member, Department of Civil Engineering.

The session was conducted for I and III B.Tech. civil engineering students. The speaker explained the industrial applications of software such as STAAD.Pro, BIM, AutoCAD, and SketchUp used in structural analysis, design, drafting, and 3D modeling. He also shared industry insights and highlighted how mastering these tools can improve career opportunities for civil engineers.

The program was conducted under the chairmanship of Dr. P. Sundara Kumar, HoD. Dr. P. Parthiban and Dr. A. V. A.
