Drug-Free Andhra Pradesh – Dandi March 2.0



Drugs are not just a health or crime issue but a serious national security threat, said Ake Ravi Krishna, IPS. He explained that money generated from drug trafficking often reaches terrorist organizations and harms the nation, describing it as “narco-terrorism.”

He addressed students at an awareness program held at Vignan’s University in Vadlamudi, Guntur district. The event was organized under the “Drug-Free Andhra Pradesh Mission – Dandi March 2.0” by Vibrants of Kalam with the support of the EAGLE team. The 1,000-kilometer cycle rally, which started on April 6 from Tirupati and will continue to Visakhapatnam, reached the university on its eighth day.

The rally aims to spread awareness among youth with the message, “The Greatest Drug-Free March on Earth.” The event poster was unveiled by Ake

Ravi Krishna and Vignan Institutions chairman Dr. Lavu Rathaiah.

Speaking to students, Ake Ravi Krishna urged them to stay away from drugs, alcohol, and tobacco and to report suspicious activities without fear. He also advised students to respect their parents’ guidance and remain cautious about online scams.

He recalled the inspiring thoughts of A. P. J. Abdul Kalam and Swami Vivekananda, encouraging youth to dream big and stand against social evils. He asked citizens to report drug-related information through the 1972 helpline and announced that an anonymous reporting app will soon be launched.

Another chief guest, Mr. Vijay Kalam, founder of Vibrants of Kalam, said true patriotism means ensuring fellow citizens are safe. Inspired by the historic movement led by Mahatma Gandhi, the



modern march includes awareness programs across 100 constituencies, youth participation, national flag rallies, and anti-drug pledges.

A 100-foot national flag rally was also conducted, and the guests were felicitated. Officials including ASP Swaroopa Rani, Tenali DSP Mallikarjuna Rao, Registrar Prof. P. M. V. Rao, deans, faculty members, and students attended the program.
