## Awareness Conference For Faculty Of Vfstr On Cardiac Arrest



A special awareness conference was organised in VFSTR on Thursday, i.e., April, 13, 2023. The programme was organised under the auspices of the Dean's Promotions, Collaborations, and Faculty Affairs Office for the faculty and other staff members. The programme was on "Heart Diseases: Origin and Prevention". The chief guest of the programme was Dr. P. Ramesh Babu, Managing Director and Chief Cardiologist,Ramesh Hospitals, Guntur, and Vijaywada He addressed the gathering and said that everyone should be vigilant about cardiac arrest. Also, it was opined that in modern life, more people are affected by heart diseases due to reasons like alcohol, smoking, fast food consumption, family tradition, gastric problems, and stress. He said that by identifying

these issues early and taking precautions, a future threat can be avoided. Blood flow to the brain is critical when cardiac arrest occurs. He explains how to provide treatment at the golden time that can save a person's life. It is claimed that 98 percent of cardiac arrests can be prevented if detected early. Everyone has to maintain their body mass index levels in a proper manner. 5G ambulances and telemedicine should be made available soon.

He explained the various questions asked by the faculty on heart diseases. After that, the chief guest was honoured by Dr. Lavu Rathaiah, Chairman.

The programme was co-attended by Vice-Chancellor Professor P. Nagabhushan, Registrar Dr. MS. Raghunathan, Deans, Heads, and teaching staff of the respective departments participated in the programme.
