1. Revision of R22 Curriculum by Dr. K. Santhi Sri, BOA member, presented the ongoing process of revising the R22 curriculum. d. Organizing Workshops and Conferences: The action plan includes organizing regular workshops and conferences to provide faculty and students with opportunities to engage with experts, learn about cutting-edge technologies, and showcase their research work.

e. Publications: The department aspires to increase the number of publications in reputable journals and conferences. To achieve this, faculty members will be encouraged to collaborate on research projects and submit their work for publication, while students will be guided in developing their research skills and submitting papers.

By addressing these key areas, the Department of Information Technology aims to strengthen its position in the academic community and ensure the growth and success of its students and faculty members.
