Guest Lecture on “Unlocking the Future with Chemistry

The Department of Chemistry, School of Applied Sciences and Humanities, Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology and Research (VFSTR), Vadlamudi, successfully organized a guest lecture on Unlocking the Future with Chemistry: Career Opportunities, Research & Innovation.

The program began with registration, followed by a welcome address by Prof. K. Prabhakara Rao, Head of the Department, who highlighted the vital role of chemistry in shaping future technologies and career paths. The invited speaker, Dr. Santhosh Kumar Chittimalla, Former Director, Syngene

International, Hyderabad, delivered an insightful session on emerging career opportunities, the significance of research and innovation in the pharmaceutical sector, and essential skills for success in industry and academia.

The session was highly interactive, with students actively engaging in discussions and clarifying their queries related to career prospects and research advancements. Following the lecture, participants were taken on a campus tour, which included visits to A-Block, H-Block, N-Block (Dr. Lara Center for energy materials) laboratories, NTR Library, and the Advanced Research Centre (ARC-AMMPC), giving them exposure to the university's infrastructure and research facilities.

The program concluded with closing remarks and certificate distribution. The event proved to be highly beneficial, offering students a broader perspective on the diverse opportunities available in the field of chemistry after graduation and motivating them to pursue excellence in research and innovation.



MBA Students Visit Guntur Textile Park



As part of an experiential learning initiative, a total of 180 MBA students from Vignan’s University visited Guntur Textile Park, Chilakaluripet, as part of experiential learning. The visit offered practical exposure to textile manufacturing, covering stages from yarn processing, warping, sizing, weaving, and looming to quality inspection, packaging, and export preparation. Industry experts explained each process, helping students understand real-time operations. Students also explored product differentiation, pricing variations, supply chain systems, and import-export procedures, linking theory with practice. The visit highlighted the university’s focus on industry-integrated learning and was coordinated by faculty members Dr. Apoorva, Dr. Lakshmi Narayanamma, and Mrs. Nagalakshmi from the Department of Management Studies.
