Vignan's Entrance Exam VSAT-2024 Phase-I Result 2024 Released Counselling to begin April 24th



The VSAT-2024 Phase-I (Vignan Scholastic Aptitude Test) has witnessed an overwhelming response this year for BTech, BPharmacy, and BSc Agriculture Science admissions at VFSTR. Prof. P. Nagabhushan, Vice-Chancellor and former director of IIT Allahabad, released the results of the entrance exam conducted through online and offline modes.

Prof. Nagabhushan expressed his happiness, stating that students from Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, and various other states across the country appeared in the exam. Those who qualify for scholarships will be awarded based on the VSAT-2024 ranks and other criteria. For instance, students who score more than 970 marks in their intermediate exams will receive a 50% scholarship; those with 950 to 969 marks will get a 25% scholarship; and those with 920 to 949 marks will receive a 10% scholarship for four years.

Similarly, scholarships will be provided to students based on their performance in the JEE Mains exam. Those who score more than 95 percentiles will receive a 75% scholarship; students with 89 to 94.9 percentiles will get a 50% scholarship; those with 80 to 88.9% percentiles will receive a 25% scholarship; and students with 70 to 79.9% percentiles will get a 10% scholarship.

He also stated that more than 90% of the students this year have secured jobs at leading institutions and have excelled in research. This has increased the popularity of the university among students and parents due to these rare achievements. Apart from the VSAT-2024 ranks, JEE Main results, EAMCET ranks, and intermediate marks will also be considered for admission.

Dr. PMV Rao, the registrar in charge, stated that VFSTR's primary objective is to develop students into world-class professionals.

He also highlighted the special Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) that the university has established with leading software companies such as Microsoft, Infosys, HCL, and TCS. These MoUs aim to provide mutual benefits and opportunities for students and companies. Furthermore, he mentioned that the university has mutual agreements with international universities to prepare their students for global competition. This strategic approach has resulted in VFSTR students securing significant positions in international companies. The presence of such partnerships and collaborations reflects the university's commitment to providing students with a comprehensive and globally competitive education.

Dean Admissions Dr. K.V. Krishna Kishore, addressing the media, said that counseling for admission to BTech, BPharmacy, and BSc Agriculture Science courses will commence at Vignan University from April 24 to 30. The VSAT Phase-II entrance exams are scheduled from May 1 to May 15.
