## Virtualization to Cloud Deployment Exploring AWS in Practice

The Department of Information Technology (IT), Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology & Research (VFSTR), in association with the Office of Industry Relations, successfully organized a technical talk titled "From Virtualization to Cloud Deployment: Exploring AWS in Practice" for III B.Tech IT students on 21 February 2026.

The session was delivered by Mr. Chaitanya Pokuri, technical specialist and senior cloud engineer at HCL Technologies Limited, Bangalore. With extensive industry experience in cloud computing and infrastructure management, he shared valuable real-time insights into virtualization and AWS deployment practices.

The inaugural session began with a welcome address by Mr. Prasad Panda, Director of Industry Relations, VFSTR, who highlighted the importance of strengthening industry-academia collaboration. The coordinators, Dr. P. Subba Rao and Dr. Hemanta Kumar Bhuyan, Associate professors, outlined the objectives of the seminar. Dr. K. Sujatha, Head



of the Department of IT, emphasized the growing significance of virtualization and cloud technologies and encouraged students to enhance their expertise in AWS to improve employability.

During the technical session, Mr. Chaitanya explained how virtualization forms the foundation of modern cloud computing and elaborated on practical AWS deployment models used in industry. He discussed real-time infrastructure management, scalability, deployment challenges, and security concerns. The session was interactive, enabling students to clarify doubts and gain a deeper understanding of cloud engineering practices.

The program effectively bridged the gap between academic learning and industry requirements, motivating students to pursue certifications and skill development in cloud technologies.



## Faculty Interaction with C-DAC Experts



Faculty members interacted with experts from the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC), Pune, who visited the campus to present an overview of their advanced computational facilities, with special emphasis on national supercomputing infrastructure. The experts explained the Government of India's support mechanisms through which high-performance computing (HPC) systems have been established across premier institutions such as the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) and National Institutes of Technology (NITs). They highlighted how institutions can leverage these national initiatives to access supercomputing resources for research and academic purposes through remote access.

The team offered technical guidance in identifying and configuring a compatible server architecture suited to the institution's requirements for establishing a supercomputing facility. They also invited faculty members to visit the Pune facility for a deeper understanding of the infrastructure and collaboration opportunities. Additionally, they mentioned the possibility of testing their upcoming Rudra platform through discussions with senior officials. The experts clarified that utilization charges for academic institutions are nil or minimal compared to commercial cloud providers and emphasized the importance of command-line interface (CLI) proficiency for effective use of HPC systems.
