Grand Inauguration of Pro-Bono Club at Vignan University: A Step Towards Social Justice and Legal Accessibility



The inauguration of the “Pro-Bono Club” was held at Vignan University’s School of Law on 20th October, 2024. That represented a significant milestone in improving access to justice for marginalized communities. The Club launched in collaboration with the Ministry of Law and Justice under the Nyaya Bandhu scheme, the club aims to bridge the gap between legal services and those in need, particularly by connecting beneficiaries with volunteer lawyers either directly through the club or via government platforms. The initiative was focused on ensuring that legal support is accessible to all, thereby promoting social equity and justice.

The Chief Guest, Justice Ravi Nath Tilhari of the Andhra Pradesh High Court, delivered an inspiring address, emphasizing the pivotal role of law students and volunteer lawyers in providing free legal services. He urged legal professionals to extend their services voluntarily to help vulnerable groups such as the poor, women, the elderly, and the disabled, both in civil and criminal cases. Justice Tilhari highlighted the importance of social responsibility within the legal profession and its role in fostering justice and fairness.



Dr. Lavu Rathaiah, Chairman, encouraged the students to not only excel in legal studies but also to embrace cutting-edge technologies such as artificial intelligence (AI), data science, and machine learning. He pointed out that these tools are already being used in various countries to resolve legal disputes efficiently, and urged students to develop expertise in these areas to advance their legal careers.

Judge M. Babitha, the Member Secretary of the AP State Legal Services Authority, informed the audience about the availability of legal aid services, mentioning that individuals seeking assistance can call the helpline number 15100. She also announced that a panel advocate would be available at Vignan University on Fridays and Saturdays to offer further support.

The event concluded with a grand felicitation of Justice Tilhari and featured prominent attendees, including legal and academic dignitaries, deans, department heads, and students. The Pro-Bono Club is expected to serve as a crucial platform for advancing social justice by providing free legal assistance to those in need, reinforcing the university’s commitment to fostering a just and equitable society.
