## Pro-Bono Club of Vignan Institute of Law Venue: Z.P High School, Vejendla village, Guntur District



The Pro-Bono Club of Vignan Institute of Law successfully organized an impactful awareness program at Z.P. High School, Vejendla Village, Guntur District, focusing on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act. This initiative, led by students, aimed to educate young minds about their rights while empowering them to recognize and report inappropriate behavior with confidence and courage. The event featured a captivating skit and compelling speeches by faculty members, leaving an indelible impression on both students and staff.

The highlight of the program was a thought-provoking skit performed by college students. This powerful narrative depicted real-life scenarios that children might face, including bullying, harassment, and inappropriate conduct from peers or adults. Through a simple yet evocative storyline, the skit showcased a young victim who, with the unwavering support of family and teachers, mustered the courage to report an incident to the authorities. It emphasized critical concepts such as distinguishing between safe and unsafe touch and the importance of speaking

to trusted adults when feeling unsafe. The skit effectively demonstrated how the POCSO Act provides a robust legal framework for addressing and reporting such offenses.

Following the skit, faculty members delivered insightful speeches to reinforce the program's key messages. Ms. Niharika, Assistant Professor at Vignan Institute of Law, elaborated on the legal provisions and penalties under the POCSO Act, explaining its role in safeguarding children under 18 from sexual offenses. Dr. Santosh Raju, another Assistant Professor, stressed the importance of equipping children with the knowledge to identify inappropriate behavior and empowering them to act without fear or hesitation. Ms. Harshita, also an Assistant Professor, emphasized the significance of fostering gender equality across all spheres of society and highlighted the necessity of vigilance and awareness. Advocate K. Sri Ram provided a nuanced perspective, underscoring that the POCSO Act is equally applicable to boys, promoting inclusivity in child protection laws.

The Headmaster of Z.P. High School concluded the program with an inspiring address, underscoring the transformative power of education in enabling children to safeguard themselves. She encouraged open communication between students, parents, teachers, and counselors to address any challenges they might face. Expressing gratitude to Vignan Institute of Law, she commended the institution for its dedication to creating meaningful and educational initiatives.



In a touching finale, some school students volunteered to demonstrate the differences between good touch and bad touch, further solidifying the program's objectives. The event concluded with the students of Vignan Institute of Law affixing Nyaya Bandhu posters within the school premises, spreading awareness and ensuring the program's messages resonate long after its conclusion.
