The two-day National Level Conference on “Recent Advances in Functional Materials in The Department of Physics



The two-day national level conference on “Recent Advances in Functional Materials” under the joint auspices of the Science and Engineering Research Boards began on March 24–25, 2023, with grandeur. The day one programme started at 9:00 a.m. The chief guest of the programme was Professor Anil K. Bhatnagar, former vice chancellor of Pondicherry University, NASI Honorary Scientist of Central University, Hyderabad.

The convener of the event, Dr. Venkayya Malapati, gave the opening remarks on the “Importance of Functional Materials,” explaining how material contributes to the advancement of a number of technologies, including medicine and health, information and communication, national security and space, transportation, structural materials, art and literature, science, the environment, etc.

The chief guest of the programme Professor Anil K. Bhatnagar, former vice chancellor of Pondicherry University, He emphasised that physics is one of the most important subjects in the field of engineering. It is a useful resource for studying throughout the engineering course due to its prominence in the academic world. It serves as the fundamental basis for all engineering topics and is important from a pedagogical perspective for all engineering students. Also, he feels that physics is the source of human life and suggests that extensive research should be done on it.

He said that students will be able to achieve good results by developing awareness of new topics and modern methods in their respective subjects. He said that currently available mobile phone-like devices can be used as materials with multi-functional capabilities. Students are advised to focus on making any object

out of a multifunctional material. Students have to study what materials the things they use every day are made of. He opined that the interest in research should be increased, only then can many innovations be ushered in that will be useful for the country. It is stated that no department can express its existence without materials.

Prof. V.V.S.S. Srikanth, University of Hyderabad, who attended the programme as another chief guest, said that the importance of multi-functional materials has increased significantly in the current technological era. Students were advised to work hard in order to increase the availability of multi-functional materials in society. The speeches and suggestions given by the scientists at this conference are multifaceted.

The vice chancellor, Dr. P. Naghabhusan, highlighted the quality of research work, which has a direct impact on the quality of teaching. He also opined that engaging in research is key to a faculty’s ongoing development. The research collaborative processes can also play a powerful role in supporting faculty in developing a common language and shared ways of working with research.

In his remarks, Dean R&D advised all faculty members to initiate internal projects with the intention of applying for externally funded projects. The organisation will offer the internal grant needed to carry out the internal project.

The dean of the School, Applied Sciences and Humanities, Dr. N. Srinivasu, emphasized the importance of multidisciplinary research as an engine for innovation. “By collaborating together, researchers from various fields can be benefited through collaboration.

The conference was co-attended by the internal dignitaries, faculty members, and students.



Internship Drive

20 I MBA and 07 II BBA students got selected as interns by the RAAM group on the drive conducted on February 21, 2023.
