Dr. Charyalu discussed various innovative and thought-provoking approaches that have emerged in recent years, enriching the way we understand and interpret literature. These trends challenge traditional methods of analysis and incorporate new theories, technologies, and cultural contexts. The engaging discussion must have enlightened the attendees on the latest developments and perspectives in the field of literature.

Some of the significant recent trends in literary studies highlighted by Dr. Charyalu include:

- 1. Interdisciplinary Field: The integration of different academic disciplines to provide a more comprehensive understanding of literature.
- Ecocriticism: An approach that explores the relationship between literature and the environment, examining how texts portray nature, ecological issues, and human interactions with the natural world.
- 3. Queer Theory: This trend examines the representation and experiences of non-heteronormative identities in literature, challenging binary notions of gender and sexuality, and exploring the complexities of queer experiences.
- 4. Cognitive Studies: The application of cognitive psychology to literary analysis, aiming to understand how readers process and interpret literary texts.
- 5. Transnationalism: The study of literature in a global context, focusing on the interconnectedness of cultures and the exchange of ideas across national borders.

The session ended with a question and answer segment. the participants clarified their doubts and expressed their opinions.
