## VFSTR Conferred with the South Asia Centre of the Year Award by Cambridge



Best Support for Teachers and Students, 2023

On invitation by Cambridge English Assessment, Chennai, the Team Leader for the Cambridge Centre (IN259) of our varsity, Prof. A. Sharada, Head, EoL, and Dr. A. Suresh Babu the Centre Exams Manager, attended the International Conference for Centre Leaders of South Asia at Colombo from September 10–12, 2023. Delegates from more than 50 Cambridge centers across South Asia participated in the conference.

On Day 1, the conference delegates were given a warm reception and introduced to the Cambridge Team, which administers the services and operations of Cambridge University Press and Cambridge Assessment in South Asia. It was followed by a spectacular show of dance performances put forth by teams of talented students from local schools in Colombo. It provided the delegates with a taste of Sri Lankan art and culture.

The cultural performance was followed by the annual Cambridge Awards ceremony to recognize the good work and efforts of some of the best-performing centers in South Asia. It was a proud moment when VFSTR was announced as the Center of the Year from South Asia for best practices and support for teachers and students. Dr. Sharada and Dr. Suresh Babu received the award on behalf of the university. The award ceremony concluded with a group photograph of the awardees.



## QS I-GAUGE Diamond Rating for VFSTR: International Accreditation



VFSTR was awarded the Diamond Rating International Accreditation in the prestigious QSI-Gauge International Accreditation announced by the QS Intelligence Unit in London. In this regard, a program was held at the Trident Hotel in Chennai.

Dr. MS Raghunathan, Registrar of Vignans University, received the official certificate by the hands of Telangana State Governor, Tamilisai Soundararajan.

The registrar addressed the media and said that nine factors are mainly considered when granting QSI-Gauge International Accreditation to the university. Among them are teaching and learning, faculty quality, employability, diversity and accessibility, facilities, social responsibility, governance and structure, research, and academic development.

In which platinum rating for 6 departments, gold rating for 2 departments, diamond rating in 1 department, and achieved diamond rating accreditation with a score of 90 percent. He also said that the rating is received every two years. The accreditation is based on academic reputation, employer reputation, faculty-to-student ratio, publication of research papers in Scopus journals, and more citations by faculty. International students are also in the right proportion, as are MoUs with universities from different countries and exchange programs.

The program was co-attended by Chairman Dr. Lavu Rattaiah, Vice Chairman Lavu Srikrishna Devarayalu, Vice Chancellor Professor P. Nagabhushan, the IQAC team, Deans, and Heads, who expressed their happiness as Vignan received a diamond rating in QSI-Gauge International Accreditation.
