Scientific Storage Exposure at CWC



An educational exposure visit was organized at the Central Warehouse Corporation (CWC), Vadlamudi, where students were provided hands-on training in scientific storage management, integrated pest control, fumigation practices, moisture management, and modern warehouse operations.

The visit enabled participants to observe real-time warehouse procedures, pest management strategies, safe storage technologies, and quality maintenance practices, effectively connecting academic learning with practical field applications. The participants were 3rd-year B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture students at Vignan's Institute of

agriculture and technology (VIAT) from the disciplines of Entomology, Genetics and Plant Breeding, and Seed Science and Technology. The visit strengthened their professional understanding of scientific storage systems, integrated pest management, quality control practices, and large-scale warehouse operations, enhancing their field-level competencies.

The program was coordinated by Dr. L. Geethanjali, Dr. P. Susmitha, and Dr. K. Amarnath. Technical sessions and demonstrations were conducted by Smt. Dhanalakshmi, Assistant Manager, CWC, along with Smt. Triveni and Smt. Kausur, technical assistants, CWC.

National Workshop on Quantum Cryptography

The Department of Information Technology at Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology, and Research organized a two-day national workshop on "Recent Trends in Quantum Cryptography" in online mode.

The keynote address was delivered by Dr. Ravi Anand, Assistant Professor at IIIT-

Delhi, who explained the foundations of quantum cryptography, including qubits, superposition, entanglement, quantum gates, and the BB84 protocol. He highlighted how quantum principles strengthen cyber security and enable secure communication through quantum key distribution (QKD).

The workshop emphasized future innovations in post-quantum cryptography and the growing need to protect data against quantum-enabled attacks. Practical challenges in implementing QKD and advancements in secure networks were also discussed. The sessions provided valuable insights into emerging research trends and real-world applications of quantum technologies.
