VFSTR Webinar: Harnessing LLMs to Build Intelligent Applications



The Department of Advanced Computer Science and Engineering at Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology and Research (VFSTR) organised a webinar on "Building Intelligent Applications with Large Language Models (LLMs)" on October 11, 2025, as part of its Content Training Initiative.

The resource person of the event was Dr. Ajay Shenoy, Ph.D. (IISc Bangalore), a data scientist and independent consultant. In his address, he provided valuable insights into the development of intelligent, data-driven applications using advanced LLM frameworks such as LangChain, Hugging Face, and Retrieval-Augmented Generation (RAG). He highlighted practical approaches to designing solutions that combine computational efficiency with real-world applicability, underscoring the growing relevance of language models in diverse domains.



The session concluded with an interactive discussion, where participants explored the potential of LLM-based tools in enhancing application design and innovation.

'True Change Begins with a Shift in Thought': World Mental Health Week concludes at VFSTR

Experts urge students to embrace positive thinking and mindful technology use as five-day 'Healing Minds' celebrations come to a close



October 12, 2025: "True change does not always manifest externally, it begins when our way of thinking changes," said Prof. G. Venkatesh Kumar, former Dean, Faculty of Science and Technology, University of Mysore, and retired professor of psychology, while addressing the valedictory session of World Mental Health Week 2025 at VFSTR.

The five-day mental health awareness series, organised by the Psychology Team of the Department of Social Sciences and Humanities in collaboration with the Dean, Student Affairs Office, was held from October 8 to 12 under the theme "Healing Minds." The initiative aimed to enhance mental health literacy, encourage positive practices, and promote emotional well-being across the campus.

The keynote address was delivered by Prof. Kumar emphasised the importance of recognising "invisible change" - the transformation



that begins with a shift in mindset. "Every individual must grant themselves permission to succeed. This self-approval unlocks one's potential," he said. He also highlighted the value of gratitude in daily life, recommending the practice of writing a 'gratitude letter' to cultivate positivity and inner peace. Explaining that the human mind functions at three levels - conscious, subconscious, and unconscious, he noted that understanding these layers empowers individuals to regulate emotions more effectively.




Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Lavu Rattaiah, Chairman of Vignan Group of Institutions, expressed concern over the excessive use of mobile phones among students, noting that "90% of them are trapped in their screens, wasting precious time, health, and thought." He urged students to reflect: "What do we truly gain by spending hours on our phones?" and stressed the importance of mindful and limited use of technology. "Mobile phones have replaced televisions, cameras, and cinemas and become an essential part of life, but their overuse can harm physical health, strain the eyes and brain," he cautioned. He encouraged students to make intelligent use of technology, devote more time to reading, and cultivate a habit of knowledge acquisition.

The event concluded with the felicitation of distinguished guests and the distribution of prizes to winners of various competitions held as part of the week-long celebrations. Deans, heads of departments, faculty members, and students attended the programme.
