Alumni-Student Interaction Held on 'Future of Work and Emerging Technologies'

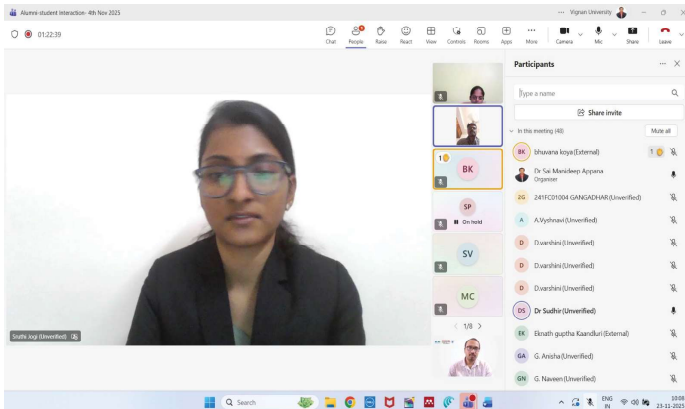
Session focused on evolving workplace skills, technology trends and industry readiness

The department of Management Studies VFSTR, has organised an Alumni-Student Interaction session on Sunday on the theme 'Future of Work: Emerging Technologies.' The programme was conducted through Microsoft Teams between 9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on date 26.11.2025, and witnessed the participation of 48 students from the MBA and BBA programmes.

The resource person for the session was Ms. Sruthi Jogi, an alumna from the MBA batch of 2019-2021 and currently serving as an HR Executive at Votary Softech Solutions. She shared her professional experiences and insights on how rapid technological advancements are redefining skill requirements, work culture, and organisational structures.

The event aimed to strengthen alumni engagement and provide students with exposure to real-time industry perspectives. Ms. Sruthi discussed major technology-driven shifts such as automation, artificial intelligence, business analytics, and digital transformation, and emphasized the growing importance of adaptability, continuous learning, and cross-domain competencies.

She highlighted the increasing intersection of human resource practices with data-driven decision-making, noting that emerging technologies are reshaping hiring processes, employee engagement systems, and performance measurement frameworks.



Students gained clarity on required future-ready skills and the evolving expectations of employers in a competitive, technology-led job market. The session also encouraged learners to explore opportunities in entrepreneurship, innovation, operations, and analytics, aligning with global workforce trends.
