# **VISAKHAPATNAM CULTURAL AND ACADEMIC TOUR**



As part of its ongoing commitment to cultural immersion and experiential learning, VFSTR University organized a five-day educational and cultural trip to Visakhapatnam from June 20 to 24, 2025, exclusively for international students. A total of 96 students representing eight countries Sudan, Nepal, Madagascar, Malaysia, Liberia, South Sudan, Zimbabwe, and Syria participated in this enriching initiative. More than a tour, this journey symbolized a celebration of diversity, intellectual curiosity, and intercultural unity. The experience offered students an opportunity to explore India's natural beauty, technological advancements, and deep-rooted cultural heritage, while also forging friendships and memories that transcend borders.

# Day 1: Departure and Warm Welcome at VIIT

On June 20th, our group departed from VFSTR Vadlamudi on a journey filled with anticipation and enthusiasm. As we travelled across scenic districts like Godavari and Gannavaram, the

changing landscapes, lush greenery, and peaceful countryside made the long hours on the road feel vibrant and captivating. Despite the bus speed being capped at 60 km/h, spirits remained high. By 8 PM, we arrived at the VIIT (Vignan's Institute of Information Technology) campus in Visakhapatnam. The hospitality shown by the VIIT team was deeply heartwarming. Students were assigned hostel accommodations and treated to a delicious dinner, including local delicacies like mutton curry and special rice. The warm welcome laid a comforting foundation for the days ahead.

Day 2: Nature and Innovation Gandhi Park & AMTZ



June 21st began with a visit to Gandhi Park, a serene and vibrant green space that offered moments of joy, laughter, and reflection. Students mingled, swung on playground swings, and took group photographs cherishing the childlike joy that such simple moments bring.

In the afternoon, the group visited Andhra Pradesh MedTech Zone (AMTZ) India's premier hub for medical device manufacturing. We explored cutting-edge facilities such as the Center for Electromagnetic Compatibility and Safety Testing, Biomaterial Testing, and 3D Printing Labs. It was an inspiring experience to witness how India is pioneering innovation in medical technology. The visit provided rare insights into the infrastructure and research driving the nation's indigenous healthcare solutions.

Day 3: Iconic Vizag - A Day of Discovery

On June 22<sup>nd</sup>, students embarked on a day- long exploration of some of Visakhapatnam's most iconic landmarks. We began at the Indira Gandhi Zoological Park one of India's largest zoological gardens where we walked amidst lush vegetation while observing wildlife in their natural habitats. The tranquility of the surroundings gave everyone a sense of peace and connection with nature.

The visit continued with a stop at the Aircraft Museum, which featured real fighter jets and exhibits about the Indian Air Force. The experience evoked feelings of awe and national pride. Following this, we enjoyed quiet moments at RK Beach, where the sea breeze and the rhythmic sounds of the ocean refreshed our minds. As the sun set, the view of the waves meeting the horizon left many of us speechless.

Our final visit for the day was to the INS Kurusura Submarine Museum. Stepping inside the decommissioned submarine offered a

rare and humbling insight into the life of naval officers beneath the sea. It gave us newfound respect for the dedication and discipline of the armed forces.

On June 23<sup>rd</sup>, we embarked on a meaningful journey across three distinct locations.
