




## Utsav-2022

#### **ANNAMACHARYAJAYANTHIUTSAVAM**

Shri Tallapaka Annamacharya, also popularly known as Annamayya, was a 15<sup>th</sup> Century Hindu saint and the earliest known Indian musician to compose "sankirtanas" in praise of Lord Venkateswara. The musical form of the keerthana songs that he composed are still popular among Carnatic music artists, and has strongly influenced the Carnatic music compositions. Annamacharya is remembered for his sanity life, and is honoured as a great devotee of Vishnu by devotees and saintly singers.

To commemorate the 614<sup>th</sup> Birth anniversary of Shri Tallapaka Annamacharya, the students of Music club have organised his Jayanthi Utsavam on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at Sangamam seminar hall from 4.30 pm to 6.30 pm. The program was organised by the students of Music club lead by their Incharge Ms. Gayathri of III Bio-Informatics, along with the support of Student Activities Council (SAC).












## **PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION- 2022**

The photography competition ended up with the prize distribution to the winners.











## SHORT STORY WRITING COMPETITION



The winners were awarded with exciting cash prizes.






# **DANCING JODI COMPETITION- 2022**

Date: 09-05-2022


Venue: Most Happening Place


## **AUDITIONS FOR MAYABAZAR**

And they appreciated the others castle their interest and participation, motivated them to participate actively.





## **Utsav Volleyball Tournament-2K22**

Date: 18th April 2022 Venue: Volleyball courts



Volleyball is a team sport in which two teams of six players are separated by a net. Each team tries to score points by grounding a ball on the other team's court under organized rules. The complete set of rules is extensive, but play essentially proceeds as follows: a player on one of the teams begins a 'rally' by serving the ball (tossing or releasing it and then hitting it with a hand or arm), from behind the back boundary line of the court, over the net, and into the receiving team's court. The receiving team must not let the ball be grounded within their court. The team may touch the ball up to three times to return the ball to the other side of the court, but individual players may not touch the ball twice consecutively. Typically, the first two touches are used to set up for an attack. An attack is an attempt to direct the ball back over the net in such a way that the team receiving the ball is unable to pass the ball and continue the rally, thus, losing the point. The team





that wins the rally is awarded a point and serves the ball to start the next rally volleyball competition was initiated by Sports contingent of Vignan University. 



#### **UTSAV CRICKET TOURNAMENT 2K22**

Cricket is a bat-and-ball game played between two teams of eleven players on a field at the centre of which is a 22-yard (20-metre) pitch with a wicket at each end, each comprising two bails balanced on three stumps. The batting side scores runs by striking the ball bowled at one of the wickets with the bat and then running between the wickets, while the bowling and fielding side tries to prevent this (by preventing the ball from leaving the field, and getting the ball to either wicket) and dismiss each batter (so they are "out"). Means of dismissal include being bowled, when the ball hits the stumps and dislodges the bails, and by the fielding side either catching the ball after it is hit by the bat, but before it





hits the ground, or hitting a wicket with the ball before a batter can cross the crease in front of the wicket. When ten batters have been dismissed, the innings ends and the teams swap roles. The game is adjudicated by two umpires, aided by a third umpire and match referee in international matches. They communicate with two off-field scorers who record the match's statistical information.



#### THEME PAINTING COMPETITION- 2022










#### **COLLAGE MAKING COMPETITION - 2022**



## **UTSAV BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT 2K22**

Basketball is a team sport in which two teams, most commonly of five players each, opposing one another on a rectangular court, compete with the primary objective of shooting a basketball (approximately 9.4 inches (24 cm) in diameter) through the defender's hoop (a basket 18 inches (46 cm) in diameter mounted 10 feet (3.048 m) high to a backboard at each end of the court, while preventing the opposing team from shooting through their own hoop. A field goal is worth two points, unless made from behind the three-point line, when it is worth three.

After a foul, timed play stops and the player fouled or designated to shoot a technical foul is given one, two or three one-point free throws. The team with the most points at the end of the game wins, but if regulation play expires with the score tied, an additional period of play (overtime) is mandated.

Players advance the ball by bouncing it while walking or running (dribbling) or by passing it to a teammate, both of which require considerable skill. On offense, players may use a variety of shots – the layup, the jump shot, or a dunk; on defence,

they may steal the ball from a dribbler, intercept passes, or block shots; either offense or defence may collect a rebound, that is, a missed shot that bounces from rim or backboard.

It is a violation to lift or drag one's pivot foot without dribbling the ball, to carry it, or to hold the ball with both hands then resume dribbling. Basketball competition was initiated by Sports contingent of Vignan University.






### **FACE PAINTING COMPETITION-2022**





Venue: Most Happening Place







## UTSAV TENNICOIT AND KHO KHO TOURNAMENT-2K22

Date: 18-04-2022 Venue: Kho Kho court



Kho kho or kho-kho is a traditional Indian sport that dates back to ancient India. It is the second most popular traditional tag game in the indian subcontinent after kabaddi. Kho kho is played on a rectangular court with a central lane connecting two poles which are at either end of the court. During the game, nine players from the chasing team (attacking team) are on the field, with eight of them sitting (crouched) in the central lane, while three runners from the defending team run around the court and try to avoid being touched. Each sitting player on the chasing team faces the opposite direction of their adjacent teammates.



At any time, one player on the chasing team (the 'active chaser'/'attacker') may run around the court to attempt to tag (touch) members of the defending team, with one point scored per tag, and each tagged defender required to leave the field; however, the active chaser cannot cross the central lane to access the other half of the field, and cannot change direction once they start running toward either pole. The chasing team can get around these restrictions if the active chaser either switches roles with a sitting teammate (by touching them on the back while saying "Kho") who is facing the other half of the court and therefore has access to it, or runs to the area behind either pole and then switches direction/half. Each team has two turns to score and two turns to defend, with each turn lasting nine minutes. The team that scores the most points by the end of the game wins. Kabaddi competition was initiated by Sports contingent of Vignan University.

The students actively participated in the competition using their skills and with a good sportive spirit. 14 teams from different departments has participated in this knockout competitions. The winners are the team from the 3 biotech and the runners are the team from 4 EEE. The winners were awarded with exciting cash prizes.



#### **MATHRIBASHA DIWAS CELEBRATIONS - 2022**



Kabaddi competition was initiated by Sports contingent of Vignan University.




A series of activities were organized to celebrate the occasion and instill patriotic fervor among the student's like






## STREET PLAY on WOMEN EMPOWERMENT



Date: 07-02-2022 to 10-02-2022. Venue: Most Happening Place










## **BOOK REVIEW EVENT-2022**



#### "TRADITIONAL WALK"




Kite flying is an intrinsic part of Makar Sankranti celebrations. Colourful kites adorn the sky from the morning of Makar Sankranti.


Respecting every religion and ritual is the main motive of Vignan's University.




## "COOKING COMPETITION"

The judgement was done on the basis of the theme, textures, both visual and physical and the colors that enhance each other.








#### Freshers Day-2021




pulled off. The aura of the music club braced the spectators by their instrumental performance with flute, guitar, drums and keyboard.

The great day ended with a full precise note by a vote of thanks at 5:20 pm and everyone dispersed with the joyous tones.








































#### National Law Day Celebrations 2021










# Bathukamma and Dandiya Celebrations-2021






# VARALAKSHMI VRATHAM - 2021


Date: 03-09-2021 Venue: A- Block,1st floor
