EUPHRESO III partnered with APAARI-CABI to operate in Southeast and South Asia to achieve this primary goal. EUPHRESO III supports its members throughout the identification, prioritization and implementation of trans-national research topics/projects. It is in this context, this international conference is sponsored by EUPHRESO.

The global food security challenge demands feeding two billion more people by 2050, requiring innovations in plant health research to protect crops from pests and diseases. Pests currently cause 20-40% of global crop yield losses, costing \$290 billion annually. Poor plant health can lead to trade restrictions and economic losses. Thus, effective plant health management is essential for global food security and competitive trade.

The submitted abstracts will be reviewed and selected for oral (or) poster presentations based on the merit. The peer reviewed articles presented in the conference will be published as a special issue in the journal "Indian Phytopathology" (Scopus Indexed, NAAS 5.97).

Guidelines for Abstract

Font: Times New Roman, 11 points; Line spacing: 1, one column of text. The abstract must be concise, with a word limit of 250 words, and should represent original work, status and analytical reviews on Plant Health. Informative and critical abstracts are accepted with the title indicating key points (without abbreviations). Select one to three relevant themes from the conference tracks for your abstract. Documents must conform to guidelines; otherwise, revisions will be requested. Submissions after the deadline will not be accepted unless an extension is granted. The abstract should be submitted in MS Word (.doc or .docx) format.

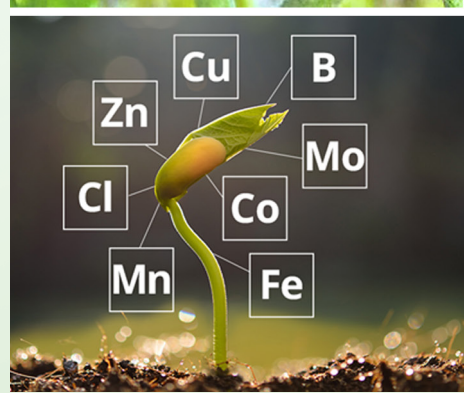

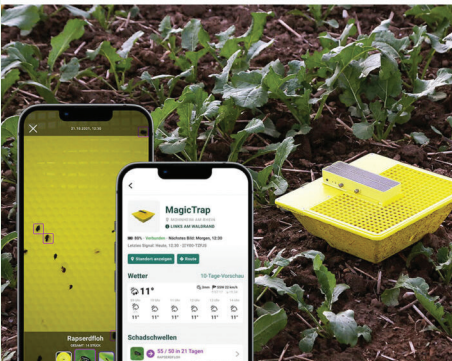
