The Following points were discussed in the meeting:

Chairman BoS has invited all the Internal and External BoS Members and presented the Rules and Regulations, Course Scheme and Syllabi of all courses of BA.LL.B(Hons.) & BBA.LL.B(Hons.).

1. Rules and Regulations of BA.LL.B(Hons.) & BBA.LL.B(Hons.)

Rules and regulations are drafted in parlance with other programmes offered by the Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology & Research. Rules regarding registration of students, attendance, promotion, evaluation and assessment, award of degree etc. are duly mapped with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Bar Council of India. Prof. Y. Satyanarayana suggested preparing the rules and regulations in order to achieve the objectives stipulated in the Vision & Mission document of the VIL.

2. Approval of Course Scheme of BA.LL.B(Hons.) & BBA.LL.B(Hons.)

Course Scheme of BA.LL.B(Hons.) & BBA.LL.B(Hons.) was prepared by keeping all the core courses as prescribed by the Bar Council of India under Rules of Legal Education Part IV. Prof. Patnaik suggested offering elective courses as per the availability of subject experts.

3. Approval of Syllabi of all courses of BA.LL.B(Hons.) & BBA.LL.B(Hons.)


A syllabus of each course is divided in to five modules. Syllabus of each course is prepared after comparing with other National law Schools following Choice Based Credit System. List of Text Books and Reference Books have been prescribed in the syllabus. Prof. Patnaik suggested to amending the syllabi of courses by improving the list of text books and reference books extensively so that students can refer many books for better understanding. His notable suggestion was accepted by the board.


Prof. Sirohi talked essence of internships and mooting skills in legal education. He emphasized on the dire need to provide necessary support to students so that they can learn the legal concepts while interning. Internships shall be made compulsory in every semester. This method is proved to be one of the best methods in imparting legal knowledge and inculcating advocacy skills in law students. His notable suggestion was accepted by the board.

Valuable suggestions given by the dignitaries were accepted and incorporated in the Course Scheme and Syllabi of BA.LL.B(Hons.) & BBA.LL.B(Hons.). Meeting was concluded with the vote of thanks to all the members of Board of Studies.
