The following points were discussed in the Department Academic Advisory Committee meeting:

1. Course Content and course structure of R25 were reviewed.

The following resolutions made after the discussion:

1. To add more NPTEL courses based on relevance, in order to enhance student learning through quality online resources.
2. To introduce Mobile Application Development as a course in the curriculum, aimed at providing students with essential skills in mobile technology and app development.
3. To include Quantum Computing as a departmental elective, to expose students to advanced and emerging technologies in computation.
4. To offer the Ethical Hacking course in the II-II semester instead of III-I, so that students can develop cybersecurity awareness at an earlier stage in their program.

The outcomes of the meeting will be placed before the BoS for the further discussion and recommendations.
