1. Review of Regulation R25 – NEP 2020 Compliant Curriculum Framework: Credits, credit distribution, assessment methods (formative and summative), grading schemes, and Honor/optional courses.
2. Proposal for introduction of 'Indian Knowledge System and Culture' as a 1-credit course integrated into the existing curriculum.
3. Proposal for introduction of 'Legal Aid and Access to Justice' as a course in VIII with Legal literacy components.
4. Proposal for introduction of 'AI, Robotics, Data Protection and Privacy Laws' as a course in IX Semester.
5. Review of pedagogical approaches: experiential learning, moot court, expert lectures, and Forensic Laboratory associations.
6. Any other academic matters with the permission of the Chairperson.

**The following resolutions made after the discussion:**

1. Resolved to recommend the integration of 'Indian Knowledge System and Culture as a 1-credit course into the BA.LLB(Hons.) and BBA.LLB(Hons.) curriculum.
2. Resolved to recommend the revision of curriculum under Regulation R25, including updated credit distribution and continuous assessment structure.
3. Resolved to recommend the introduction of new courses – 'Legal Aid and Access to Justice' and 'AI, Robotics Law & Data Protection and Privacy Laws.
4. Resolved to recommend the inclusion of Moot Court and Debate as a value-added course for students.
5. Resolved to recommend incorporation of CSR and ESG topics in Corporate Governance syllabus.

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT (ATR)

Recommendation of DAAC	Action Taken Report (ATR)
Integration of NEP 2020 compliant Regulation R25 framework into BA.LLB(Hons.) and BBA.LLB(Hons.) programmes.	The Regulation R25 framework was incorporated into the curriculum structure with revised credit distribution, formative and summative assessment pattern, honor/optional courses and continuous assessment methodology.
Introduction of Indian Knowledge System and Culture as a 1-credit course.	The course 'Indian Knowledge System and Culture' was introduced into the curriculum as a mandatory 1-credit course emphasizing Indian legal traditions and cultural jurisprudence.
Introduction of Legal Aid and Access to Justice course in VIII Semester.	The course 'Legal Aid and Access to Justice' was introduced with components relating to legal literacy, clinical legal education, para-legal services and community outreach programmes.
Introduction of AI, Robotics, Data Protection and Privacy Laws course.	A new course on 'AI, Robotics Law, Data Protection and Privacy Laws' was incorporated into the curriculum to address emerging technology-law interface issues and contemporary legal developments.
Revision of Corporate Law-II syllabus to include IBC and modern corporate governance practices.	The syllabus of Corporate Law-II was revised to incorporate Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC), corporate restructuring, ESG compliance and evolving corporate governance mechanisms.
Inclusion of CSR and ESG topics in Corporate Governance syllabus.	Topics relating to Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) compliance were incorporated into the Corporate Governance syllabus.
