Vignan Institute of Law conducted DAAC meeting for the BA.LLB(Hons.) & BBA.LLB(Hons.), 2 Year LLM (proposed) and PHD programmes on 13.11.2025 from 10 am at the Director, VIL Chamber.

The following agenda points were discussed in the DAAC meeting:

1. Curriculum structure of BA.LLB(Hons.) & BBA.LLB(Hons.), course programmes with the necessary changes as per the Bar Council of India norms.
2. Curriculum structure of LL.M. (2 years) course programme for the AY 2026-2027.
3. Curriculum structure of Ph.D.
4. Introduction/revision of Courses and recommendation to BOS

The following resolutions made after the discussion:

1. DAAC Chairperson Dr. Partha Sarothi Rakshit suggested the introduction of mediation and conciliation in the final semester as per the BCI vide circular BCI:D: 1897 :2020 (323/2020) dated 13.08.2020. The syllabus for the subject will be framed as stated by the council norms; after thorough discussion all the members accepted the proposal to introduce the 4 credit course for the forthcoming academic year 2026-2027 onwards.
2. The BCI vide approval of affiliation letter BCI: D:394: 2025 (le/App/afflin) dated 17.10.2025 suggested the introduction of computer course as well as appointment of core faculty for computer learning. The current BA LLB (H.) and BBA LLB (H.) course curriculum already has basic computer at IT skills. The DAAC member Mr. Romil Aryan, Assistant Professor and Mr. Abhinav Deep Dora suggested to introduce Advanced computer learning for the final semester law students. The course will incorporate the AI and legal research methodology etc which will help the law students in industry, courtroom practice and higher studies. All the members agreed and accepted the proposal.
3. Dr. Santhosh Raju and Dr. L. Haritha suggested to change the assessment pattern of seminar papers and include written exam as per the university norms. The members after thorough discussion suggested the comparative analysis with other universities and BCI relating to UG level dissertation and accordingly suggested to change the Assessment pattern of these subjects in the formative and summative pattern. 40% for the project, 20% for the external viva and 40% for the written exam. The syllabus modification will be done accordingly.
4. Dr. Sachin Kumar Sharma, Ms. G. Neeharika, BNS Sri Ram and Mr. Ritul Aryan, Assistant Professor, VIL pointed out that the alteration/ modification of the syllabus of a few subjects were necessary to be incorporated. The subjects are following; Interpretation of Statute (IOS) (Alteration and shifting from 2nd year to 4th year), any core law paper will be introduced in 3rd semester because students should understand basics of law before learning Interpretation of statute, Legal Methods and Research, Law of Contract- II, the Right to Information, Mergers and Acquisitions, Air and Space Law (modification of syllabus is required).
5. The VIL is committed to follow the BCI norms and directive regarding subject allocation and preparation of syllabus because it is a professional course governed by the BCI.
6. The DAAC members suggested the introduction of 2-year full time LLM degree course instead of 1 year LLM as recommended by the BCI (vide approval of affiliation letter BCI: D:394: 2025 (le/App/afflin) dated 17.10.2025). The members suggested that the VIL will offer specialization of Constitutional and Administrative law, Intellectual Property Rights, Corporate Law and Criminal Law in 2 years (4 semester) LLM degree course.
7. The resolutions made after the discussion will be presented in the forthcoming CMDC and BoS meeting.

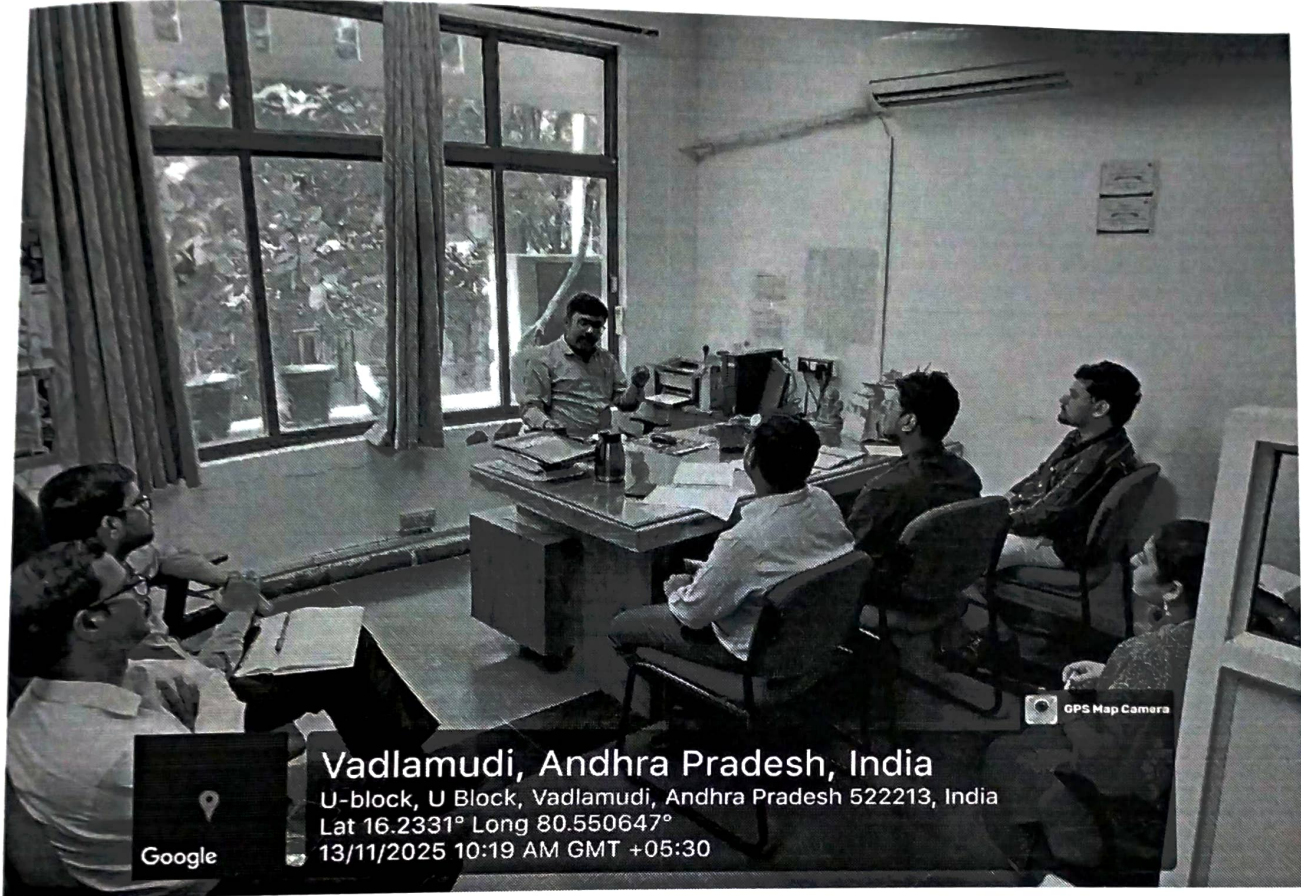
