Policy on Ending Poverty in All Its Dimensions

Scope

Governance & Responsibilities

The Vice-Chancellor will serve as the executive sponsor of this policy. A Steering Committee on Poverty Alleviation and SDG 1 will oversee implementation, supported by the Social Impact and Sustainability Cell. The committee will coordinate activities across academic and administrative units to ensure compliance and measurable progress.

Monitoring, Evaluation & Reporting

The Social Impact and Sustainability Cell will conduct annual reviews to track key performance indicators such as research output, student participation, outreach project outcomes, and measurable community impact. Findings will be reported through the University's annual sustainability report.
