The BoS meeting in the morning session with the R19 presentation given by the HoD – CE, Dr. N. Ruben; who highlighted the salient features of the Syllabus and impressed upon them the basic essence of the syllabus. He explained the project centric orientation of the syllabus and how the department plans to achieve the same.

After, the presentation, Mr. P. Sathish – R19 coordinator of the department began the point by point analysis of the various comments provided by each external member of the Department BoS. The various aspects of the syllabus and its shortcomings were discussed in great breadth and depth to arrive at effective resolutions and solutions to the problems identified. All the changes suggested were incorporated into the curriculum.

During the afternoon session, the syllabus for each course was discussed upon in detail. Some minor re-arrangements were made to a few course syllabi, to achieve continuity while maintaining a uniform work load throughout the duration of the course.

The session ended on a very positive note, regarding the approach of the university towards on-hand projects and special attention was given to the societal centric projects scheduled in the syllabus.

The external members suggested some innovative ideas such as inclusion 1-day skill development workshops into the respective courses (like workshops on paints, plumbing, masonry and concrete etc.). They also suggested that, the open-electives offered by the Civil Department to other students should also include a stream on the basics of civil engineering, so that all engineers are given a chance to understand the basic concepts of construction. The BoS members suggested the inclusion of one course on Building Information Modelling (BIM), which the Department is looking to include into the curriculum with the support of experts in the industry.

The department hopes that the efforts of the BoS members, both external as well as internal will result in an excellent curriculum; which will, at the end of four years, generate industry ready, socially responsible professionals, who are up to date, in the various emerging industrial trends.
